



Student Project Scholarship Application 2024-2025

Scholarship Description:

The Alliance for Disability in Healthcare Education (ADHCE) is offering a scholarship of up to \$1,000 to an individual or group of healthcare professional students (any discipline) with a program/project that enhances healthcare education in disabilities. The program/project should meet the following criteria:

- Student led project
- Project spans or involves multiple disciplines
- Must address 1 or more of the [ADHCE Core Competencies](#)
- Preference given to projects that provide community involvement and/or outreach.

Application Guidelines:

- 1. Projects Proposal (1-2 double-spaced pages)**
 - a. Brief background, goal(s) and objectives
 - b. Description of how the program/project addresses at least one of the ADHCE Core Competencies
 - c. Implementation plan
 - d. Who will be involved in the program/project and their roles
- 2. Budget (one page)**
 - a. Itemize expected expenses for the program or project. These could include costs of flyers/advertising for meetings, costs of materials, honoraria for speakers (if you have disability advocates as speakers, we expect reasonable honoraria), light snacks at a meeting. Provide information on the entity to which funds should be sent. This is preferably a department/philanthropy office/student aid office or similar. If unsure, please let us know.
- 3. Resume or CV from the person submitting the application**
- 4. Letter of support from Faculty or Community Sponsor**
